Visit the fortress Golubac and the ancient Bulgarian capital of Veliko Tarnovo. Cruise through the dramatic views of Iron Gates Gorge – a natural border between Serbia and Romania. Enjoy a thrilling ride through the Danube Delta by boat and immerse yourself in nature. After your cruise, spend one night in Bucharest exploring its old-world charm, tree-lined boulevards and witness its socialist architecture. Ending the program in Istanbul, explore a city where Europe and Asia meet. A vibrant metropolis known for its rich history, stunning architecture, and bustling markets. Walk through ancient streets once home to the Byzantine and Ottoman empires, marvel at sites like the Hagia Sophia and the Blue Mosque. We cross the Bosphorus Strait to literally go from one continent to another.

DAY 1 / SUN. AUG 29, 2027 DEPART CANADA

Depart for your flight to Vienna.

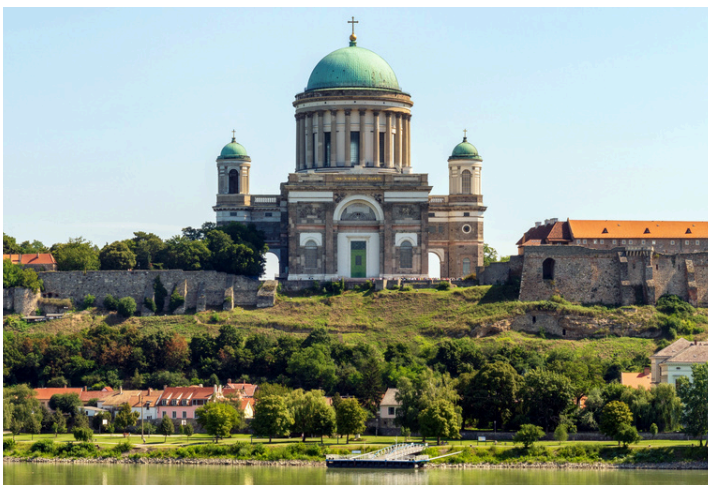
DAY 2 / MON, AUG 30, 2027 ARRIVE IN VIENNA, AUSTRIA – EMBARKATION (D)

Upon arrival in Vienna airport, we meet our coach and assistant, and transfer to the pier for embarkation. Here in one of Europe's finest Imperial cities is where your adventure begins aboard our luxury AMADEUS vessel. Join our Cruise Director for a Welcome Cocktail and raise your glass to celebrate new adventures. Our chef will spoil you with a lovingly created Welcome Dinner before your ship sets sail for Bratislava at night.

DAY 3 / TUE, AUG 31, 2027 VIENNA – BRATISLAVA (B, L, D)

A new memory for your travel diary: As the sun rises, we arrive in the Slovakian capital. Located at the confluence of the Morava and Danube Rivers, Bratislava impresses with its Gothic and Baroque architecture.

During the morning we enjoy **Excursion: Bratislava – Beauty on the Danube**, get to know the capital of the young Slovakian Republic. The driving tour passes St. Martin's Cathedral and the Grassalkovich Palace and continues to the castle hill above the old town, where you will have a stunning, panoramic view of the city and surrounding areas. Afterwards a guided walking tour leads you through the old town. Take a leisurely stroll from Michael's Gate through the historic city center, admire sights such as the Primatial Palace and St. Martin's Cathedral, a former coronation cathedral for Hungarian kings, as well as the Academia Istropolitana, the oldest university of the city, dating back to the 15th century. See the main square with the old City Hall, the Opera House and Maximilian Fountain. From the Main Square we continue to a cozy out of the way place to enjoy the famous Pressburger rolls with nut and poppy seed filling. We will end our walk at the historical Opera House in front of glorious Ganymede's Fountain. Afterwards, you are free to explore or walk the short distance back to the ship. Back on board, enjoy a leisurely lunch before departing for the local wine region. Before midnight, the ship weighs anchor for the next port, Esztergom.

DAY 4 / WED, SEPT 01, 2027 ESZTERGOM – BUDAPEST (B, L, D)

A sight as if created by angels: The Basilica of Esztergom is Hungary's largest and perhaps most beautiful church. Its splendor unfolds in the morning with **Excursion: Esztergom, Visegrád castle and Szentendre**. The tour departs from Budapest and takes you to the artists' village of Szentendre, home to many generations of Hungarian artists since the early 20th century. Many museums and contemporary galleries represent the rich traditions of the visual arts in this town. Works of the ceramist Margit Kovács (1902–77) are displayed in a famous, eponymous Museum. The focal point of Szentendre is Foetér, the main square, lined with eateries, cafes, and souvenir stores. Continue to the imposing ruined fortress of Visegrád, where you have a glorious view of the famous "Danube Bend". The next highlight of this excursion is Esztergom, the former residence of the Hungarian kings and seat of the Archbishop. Visit the imposing domed basilica – the largest cathedral in Hungary. Built in the early 19th century, it incorporates an ornate red marble chapel from an earlier church.

Meanwhile, the vessel glides towards Budapest, the "Queen of the Danube".

Enjoy an afternoon **Excursion: Taste the Flavours of Budapest**, beginning with a visit to the Market Hall.

Built in 1896, Budapest's oldest and largest indoor market offers a variety of Hungarian specialties, including Tokaj wine, langos, and paprika. Travel by bus to City Park to admire the romantic Vajdahunyad Castle and the magnificent Széchenyi Baths, one of Europe's largest and most popular thermal baths. Take a ride on Europe's second oldest metro back to the city center and stop at a local pastry shop to enjoy a slice of fluffy cake and a cup of coffee, before marveling at the stunning St. Stephen's Basilica. In the evening, experience Budapest illuminated on a scenic cruise, accompanied by a lively folklore show of music, dance, and local artistry.

DAY 5 / THUR, SEPT 02, 2027

VUKOVAR (B, L, D)

In eastern Croatia, **your Excursion: Vukovar, Osijek and Kopački Rit** begins in baroque Vukovar, home to the largest cargo port in the former Yugoslavia. Drive past elegant mansions and pre-war factory sites before heading to Kopački Rit, the largest nature park in the region, while learning about everyday Croatian life.

Take a boat tour through the stunning wetlands and marshes, then visit Kopačevo's Rural House to see traditional fishing tools and hear humorous stories from local fishermen, with tastings of Croatian specialties like fruit brandy, local wine, smoked sausage, ajvar, and homemade cakes. Continue to Osijek to explore the old town and its 18th-century baroque fortress, including the Church of the Raising of the Holy Cross, fortress walls, the "Watergate," and the main square with Croatia's largest baroque statue, museums, galleries, schools, and pubs. Return to Vukovar via a scenic drive past Croatia's first brewery, then board the ship for a leisurely dinner as you cruise toward Belgrade.

DAY 6 / FRI, SEPT 03, 2027

BELGRADE (B, L, D)

In the morning, we introduce you to the capital of Serbia, Belgrade. On our **Excursion: Dynamic Belgrade & Kalemegdan Fortress**, the Kalemegdan Fortress tells the story of a tumultuous past. First, the tour takes you to the Kalemegdan fortress, where you'll have an impressive panoramic view over the Danube and the Sava Rivers. Afterwards, you can see the National Museum, the parliament, the Terazije square and the palace of princess Ljubica. Another highlight is the St. Sava Cathedral, the largest Orthodox church in the world. After a refreshment break at a local restaurant, our tour ends with a visit to the pedestrian zone where you will find many shops and art galleries.

In the evening, enjoy a bus **Excursion: Bohemian quarter Skadarlija & Serbian folklore**. A coach takes you through Belgrade by night to a hotel in the city center, where you will enjoy a splendid folklore show. The ensemble will invite you for a glass of wine and will perform dances from all parts of the country. The costumes are very colorful and various pieces of Serbian folk music will be performed. Then you will drive to Skadarlija, the famous artists' quarter, also known as the Montmartre of Belgrade. Stroll through the narrow cobbled streets and end the day in one of the many restaurants or pubs.

DAY 7 / SAT, SEPT 04, 2027

GOLUBAC - DONJI MILANOVAC (B, L, D)

This morning we enjoy **Excursion: Visit of the fortress Golubac**, a medieval town and fortress complex. Imposing stone walls and towers are impressive reminders of the tumultuous history of this strategic fortress. Originally a Roman settlement, it has been fought over for thousands of years, and is famous for successfully withstanding over 120 direct attacks. From atop the towering ramparts, soak in the history and the stunning views of the natural landscapes of the mighty Danube, before strolling back to your waiting ship.

Rejoin the ship in Donji Milanovac and spend the afternoon on board for a truly impressive natural spectacle. Take a seat on the sun deck and relax as we cruise through one of the most impressive gorges in Europe which also marks the border between Serbia and Romania. One section of the Cazan Gorge near the town of Orșova, the Danube narrows to a scant 200 meters wide and 80 meters deep. The majestic views of the Carpathian and Balkan mountains paint a memorable scene. As we cruise, be sure to look for the small monastery church of Mraconia and the enormous 40-meter rock sculpture of the Dacian King Decebalus near Dubova.

DAY 8 / SUN, SEPT 05, 2027

SVISHTOV – ROUSSE – GIURGIU (B, L, D)

At lunchtime you arrive in the Bulgarian town of Svishtov, the southernmost point on the Danube. The afternoon **Excursion: Veliko Tarnovo and the Tsarevets Fortress**, takes you towards Veliko Tarnovo in a comfortable coach. Picturesquely located on the steep banks of the river Yantra at the foot of the Balkan Mountains, the houses of this medieval town were built on narrow terraces along the steep, rocky slopes. Pass by the fortress Zarewez, where 22 tsars made history in the 2nd Bulgarian empire. You will also visit the 13th-century church St. Peter and Paul, which is one of the few medieval churches which had been kept intact and used for worship since the beginning of the 13th century until the earthquake in 1913. At the end of the tour you will have time to enjoy and shop for local arts and crafts before returning to the ship which docks in Giurgiu for the evening.

DAY 9 / MON, SEPT 06, 2027 HARSOVA (B, L, D)

Today's **Excursion: Constanta & Murfatlar: A Black Sea Journey with Wine Tasting**. Dive into the rich history and explore the most renowned wine region of Romania on this full-day excursion. Begin with a scenic drive to Constanța, where a guided panoramic tour and walking visit showcase the city's historic landmarks. Discover Romania's cultural heritage at the Folk Art Museum before continuing to the famous Murfatlar wine region. At Murfatlar, enjoy a traditional welcome, a wine tasting, and a light lunch with live folk music. End the day with a relaxing drive back to the ship.

DAY 10 / TUE, SEPT 7, 2027

FETESTI – DISEMBARKATION – BUCHAREST (B, L, D)

Disembark in Fetești after breakfast - but your journey does not end there. A transfer will take you to another adventure on land: Bucharest. Get ready to explore the capital city of Romania, which has developed its very own charm with a lively cityscape and colourful mix of buildings from different eras. Spend an afternoon sightseeing in this vibrant metropolis of two million people. After a typical local lunch, you will check into a centrally located hotel, before joining us for a farewell dinner.

BUCHAREST – ISTANBUL, TURKEY (B, D)

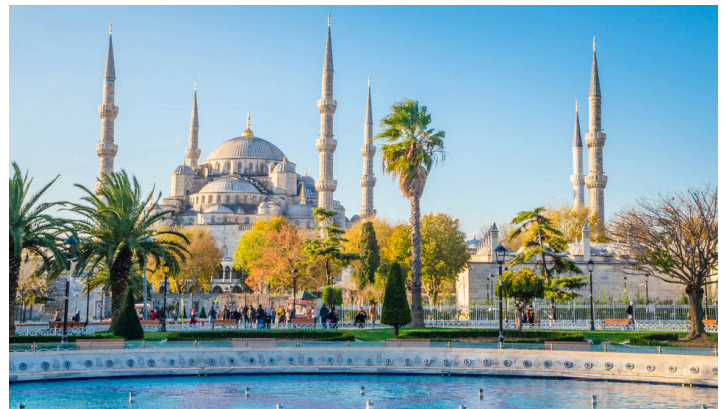
Welcome to Turkey! Upon arrival in Istanbul, meet your local guide and coach and transfer to hotel in Istanbul. Dinner included at hotel.

ISTANBUL CITY TOUR (B, L)

A beautiful example of Old-World architecture, this museum showcases lovely Christian murals and Islamic symbols throughout. After the Hagia Sophia, visit Istanbul's similarly beautiful Blue Mosque, named for the Blue İznik tiles that cover its interior. For those who are interested, be guided to the lively Grand Bazaar and venture through the market before returning to your hotel. Lunch included at local restaurant. Evening and dinner on your own.

DAY 13 / FRI SEPT 10, 2027 TOPKAPI PALACE & HAREM (B, D)

Admire the grandeur of the spectacular Ottoman Sultans' Grand Palace of Topkapi, home to every Sultan from the 15th-19th centuries. During your tour, marvel at the private chambers of the Sultans, the Harem (women's quarters) and the Imperial Treasury's vast collection, including the jewel-encrusted Topkapi Dagger and the stunning 86-carat Spoonmaker's Diamond. Free time for lunch on your own.

Farewell dinner night at a local restaurant and enjoy a local folklore performance before returning to your hotel.

DAY 14 / SAT, SEPT 11, 2027 DEPART ISTANBUL (B)

After breakfast bid farewell to Istanbul as you transfer to the airport for your flight back to Toronto.

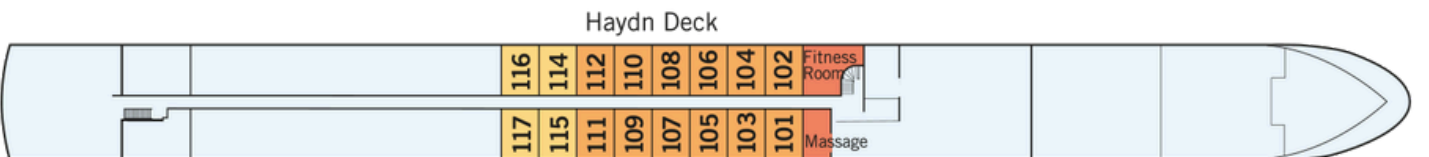
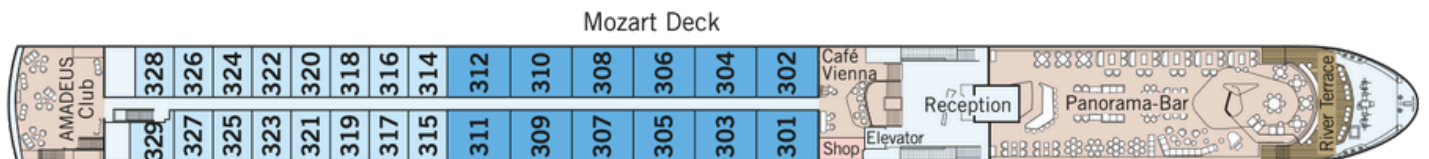
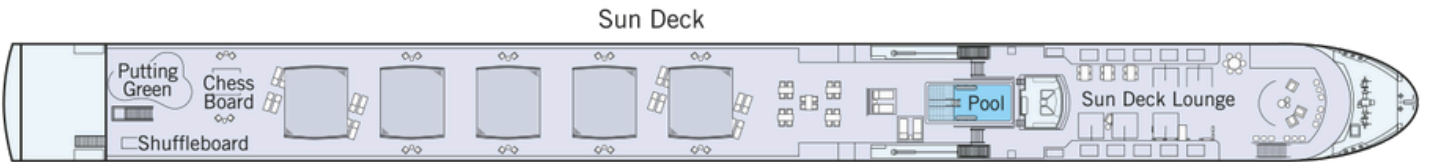
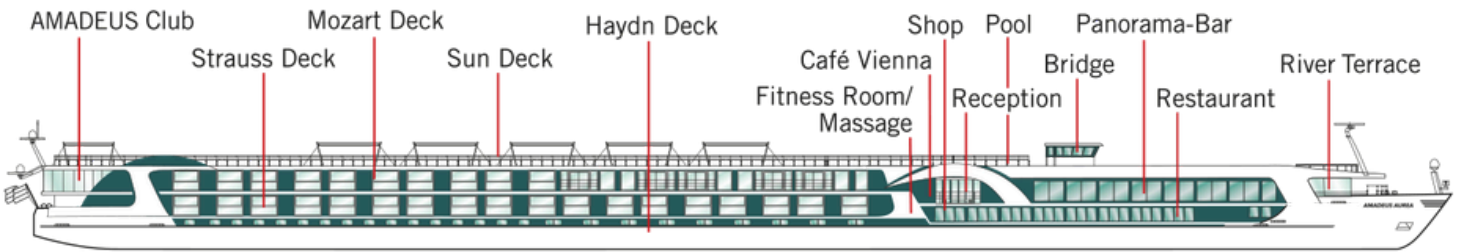


A-1 Cabin (17.5m²) with drop-down panoramic window

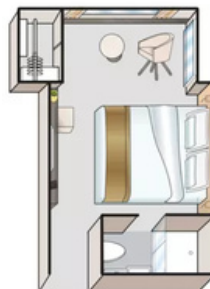
DECK PLAN
